Many psychologists will be demonstrating today throughout France to contest the measures of the government which, according to them, threaten their profession. Indeed, Emmanuel Macron may announce today, during the convention on mental health, the generalization of reimbursements of appointments at 22 euros per half hour. The rate is deemed disproportionate by the professionals.

SOS Médecins is no longer on strike. The 1,300 physicians who are members of the federation yesterday stopped their activity to request an increase in the price of home visits from 35 to 56 euros. Although they are no longer on strike, other actions may be carried out in the coming weeks.

Today is D-Day for "les versts". Online votes for the second round of the environmentalists' primaries end today. We will know who, of Yannick Jadot or Sandrine Rousseau will represent the party in the presidential election. The results will be known this afternoon at 5.30 p.m.

Jean Castex is expected at the HLM Congress today. The Prime Minister will announce a series of measures to encourage local authorities and donors to launch projects. In particular because of the health crisis, the pace of the construction of new housing has significantly declined.

Meanwhile Marseille, garbage collectors are going on strike again to protest against their working conditions.

The Aix-Marseille Provence metropolitan area has planned to sharply increase the working time of its agents.

Singer R. Kelly is convicted of sex crimes by a New York court. The former RnB star led for several years a "system" of sexual exploitation of young women, including minors. Placed in pre-trial detention, he will know his sentence next May. He faces life imprisonment.
