Medically assisted procreation is now possible for all women. The law enforcement decree appeared this morning in the official journal. The law extends access to medically assisted procreation to female couples and single women, and was signed this morning by Olivier Véran.

Another announcement from the Minister of Health: the launch of a free number to help French people in psychological distress. The line 31 14 will be available from Friday. It will allow French people who are having a particularly difficult time to find comfort.

An extraordinary and disturbing rape case in Vaucluse. A 68-year-old man is suspected of having drugged his wife for years before delivering her to men contacted on the internet. Hundreds of films and photos were found on the computers and phones of the victim's husband. A total of 44 people have been arrested, including 9 just yesterday. Thirty have been indicted and imprisoned.

A national tribute will be paid today to Master Corporal Maxime Blasco, who died in action in Mali. The funeral procession will cross the Alexandre III bridge in Paris before a speech by President Emmanuel Macron at 4:30 pm. Tomorrow, another tribute will be made to him in Isère. Master Corporal Maxime Blasco was killed on Friday during a reconnaissance operation of the jihadist forces.

Yannick Jadot will represent the ecologists in the presidential election after his victory in the primary of the Greens. He narrowly won against Sandrine Rousseau, with a little more than 51% of the vote. The candidate has outlined his program, which includes an investment plan of 50 billion euros per year in greening the economic model.
