The High Authority for Health recommends a third dose of vaccine for caregivers. The health agency recommends this for all professionals working with vulnerable people. Families of immunocompromised people are also encouraged to receive a new injection. Currently, only people 65 years old and over as well as those suffering from co-morbidities are taking a third dose.

Another very emotional day at the trial of the attacks of November 13: From today, the survivors and relatives of the victims of the Bataclan are called to testify. They all describe scenes of war and horror. The massacre in the concert hall resulted in 90 deaths out of the 130 people present that evening.

New searches are carried out in Cagnac-les-Mines, to try to find Delphine Jubillar. The nurse has been missing since last December. Speleologists are on site to probe the cavities near the couple's home. The hearing of the husband, Cédric Jubillar, is scheduled for mid-October. He has been in pre-trial detention since June 18.

The price of gas increases by 25% on European markets, which is a new historical record. This increase has been reflected for several weeks on consumers' bills. After a previous increase of nearly 9% in September, the regulated gas rates once again increased by more than 12% on October 1. Jean Castex announced a rate freeze during the winter in order to compensate for these successive increases.

Parisians bid farewell to Bernard Tapie. A religious service was held this morning in Paris in tribute to the former businessman who passed away on Sunday. Several hundreds of people gathered in front of the church of Saint-Germain-des-Prés for a last goodbye. Inside, nearly 300 guests were present.

And then soccer with the first semi-final of the Nations' League tonight. Italy will face Spain. The second semi-final, France-Belgium, will be played tomorrow. *Les Bleus* have arrived today in Italy, in Turin, where the game will be played.
