The "France 2030" plan will be presented this morning at 10 am by Emmanuel Macron. The plan is to invest several tens of billions of euros in several areas, such as digital, green industry, nuclear, and agriculture. The objective of the France 2030 plan is to allow France to compete with the other major world powers.

After weeks of hesitation, Xavier Bertrand has finally said "yes". He will participate in the congress organized by the Républicains party, on December 4th. This was announced last night. The president of the Hauts-de-France did not wish to go through the primary box, which according to him was "a source of division".

Almost a week after his controversial remarks, Monsignor Eric de Moulins-Beaufort, president of the Conference of Bishops of France, is summoned today to Place Beauvau. The man declared that the secrecy of confession was stronger than the laws of the Republic, after the publication of the Sauvé report pointing to the sexual crimes committed in the Church. Obviously, these comments were not appreciated by Minister of the Interior Gerald Darmanin, and a meeting is scheduled between the two men at 2 pm.

Abroad, 3000 inhabitants of the Spanish island of La Palma are confined at home after a volcanic eruption. The lava from the Cumbre Vieja volcano, which erupted for more than 3 weeks, destroyed a cement plant, releasing potentially toxic gas. The local authorities therefore call on residents to stay at home.

The price of fuel continues to climb, and has never been so high according to the Ministry of Ecological Transition, at more than 1 euro 53 per liter of diesel. The increase is partly explained by a strong global demand and a surge in the price of oil

And finally, which film will represent France at the Oscars 2022? The National Center of Cinematography must give its answer today, with three films in the running: Titanium,

Bac Nord, and L'Evénement. The 94th Oscars ceremony will take place next March in Los Angeles.
