Will the sanitary pass be enforced until July 31, 2022? The measure is being examined from today in the National Assembly. The objective is to be able to take advantage of this measure in the event of a resumption of the epidemic. But the opposition is having none of it and denounces this 8-month extension. At this moment, the sanitary pass is supposed to end on November 15.

Meanwhile, the vaccine booster campaign is lagging behind in France. Only 34% of people eligible for the booster vaccine have received a new injection. The government spokesman Gabriel Attal asks the French to get their third vaccination. For now, only people over 65, people with comorbidities and caregivers are eligible.

Nicolas Sarkozy will be heard by the court. The Paris court orders the hearing of the former president in the Elysee polls trial, as a witness. Five people are on trial, including the former secretary general of the presidency Claude Guéant. They are accused of having commissioned multiple opinion polls for several million euros, without a call for tenders.

The parent of a student is in custody in Valence, after congratulating his son who disrupted the tribute to Samuel Patty last Friday by shouting Allah Akbar. The father, informed by the middle school, insulted and threatened the staff. In all, about a hundred incidents were reported throughout France during ceremonies that took place in schools.

To finish: From today, squatters in building halls risk a 200-euro fine. This experiment is launched in six cities, including Rennes, Lille and Marseille to fight drug trafficking by attacking lookouts. The measure is intended to be generalized throughout the national territory from the first quarter of 2022.
