Will medical secrecy be lifted at school? The assemblée nationale has voted on an amendment allowing school heads to have access to the vaccination status of students. The goal is to facilitate their return to class. Opponents have denounced this as a violation of medical confidentiality.

And a heated debate on the health pass. At 74 against 73 votes, the deputies adopted the article, which plans to extend the use of the health pass until July 31st, 2022. The text has been criticized by the entire opposition. The reduction of the health pass will be discussed in mid-November if the situation allows it.

In Brazil, Bolsonaro has been questioned for his management of the pandemic. A parliamentary commission of inquiry calls for his indictment for ten crimes, including "crimes against humanity". With 600,000 deaths, Brazil is the most bereaved country in the world behind the United States. However, the Brazilian president has always denied the seriousness of the epidemic. Bolsonaro has stated that he is "guilty of absolutely nothing".

The French will be enjoying their All Saints holidays tomorrow evening. Bookings have skyrocketed, with an increase of 55% compared to 2019. The preferred destination remains the countryside. The Loire Valley center and Bourgogne Franche Comté are popular, and the number of visitors to these areas has doubled.

There will be red mullet as a starter in Provence, a pot au feu in Paris, and a chestnut dessert in the Ardèche.
