Trains carrying fresh produce will be making their return today and Jean Castex will be in Perpignan for one of the train's maiden voyage. The new freight train will be heading to Rungis international market, which is famously where most Paris restaurants source their produce. Freight trains have not been running for the past two years due to a lack of customers.
