Emmanuel Macron will be visiting a robotics factory in the Loire today. The President's visit to the factory in Saint-Étienne is the occasion to announce funding packages for the sector. As part of the France 2030 investment plan, 30 billion euros will be released to fund robotics.

Meanwhile, Marine Le Pen will be flying to Hungary today. The head of the far right National Rally party will be meetings president Viktor Orban tomorrow in Budapest. Marine Le Pen comes hot on the tail of her rival, Eric Zemmour who visited Budapest last month. President Viktor Orban is known for his strong positions on immigration and homosexuality.
