Emmanuel Macron is traveling to the Loire, for the first time since the start of his mandate. The president will visit a factory specializing in robotics in Saint-Étienne this morning. He will then stop off at Montbrison to survey an industrial wasteland. This visit is part of the France 2030 investment plan, which is worth 30 billion euros over five years.

The question of the security of the 2024 Olympics is at the heart of a ministerial committee today. The committee is chaired by the Minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin, and leaders of the police and the national gendarmerie will be present. Among the topics discussed is the safety of the opening ceremony, which will take place on the Seine.

She has made her first campaign proposals. Anne Hidalgo promises a revaluation of the minimum wage of between 10 and 15%. According to the socialist presidential candidate, it is important to increase wages so that it is “possible to live with dignity”. Anne Hidalgo also proposes the opening of the right to vote from the age of 16 years.

Alain Fisher is optimistic about the health situation. According to the government vaccine man, if there are no new variants, we should gradually see the epidemic fade away, with small ripples. The virus could become endemic, that is, a virus that is present but does not cause severe infection.

Meanwhile, will Moderna's vaccine be approved as a booster? The European Medicines Agency issues its decision today. In France, health authorities recommended in mid-October to use the Pfizer-BioNtech vaccine exclusively for the booster dose.

A rally will begin in a few minutes in Creil, in the Oise, as a tribute to Shaïna. This 15-year-old teenager was stabbed and burned in 2019, two years after denouncing the gang rape of which she had been a victim. The main suspect will soon be referred to the juvenile assize court.
