Developing renewable energies and building new nuclear power plants are RTE's avenues for achieving carbon neutrality in France by 2050. After 2 years of work, the electricity network has submitted its report to the government today. However, the ecological presidential candidate Yannick Jadot denounces the report and evokes an incomplete and biased vision based mainly on a single trajectory of evolution of electricity consumption in France.

Can the sanitary pass be extended until July 31? The government would like to do so but the Senate is not favorable to this extension. Senators in fact intend to exclude from the bill voted in the assembly a few days ago, any extension of the measure after February 28. Several amendments have been submitted in this regard today.

About a hundred people gathered today in Creille in the Oise two years after the murder of Shaïna, a 15-year-old girl stabbed then burned alive while she was pregnant. Her boyfriend, a 17-year-old teenager at the time, was quickly indicted and placed in custody. He will be judged in mid-November.

The 48-year-old journalist had already won the readers "Landerneau prize" for this fiction which evokes the arrival of a disabled child within a family of several siblings.
