The extension of the sanitary pass will be presented to the Senate. The upper house, dominated by the right-wing opposition, should introduce a review clause. This would require the government to return to parliament at the end of February as part of the bill on the health pass. As a reminder, the government plans to introduce the possibility of using the health pass until next July.

“Operation Azur”, the secret project of Remy Daillet revealed in Le Parisien. The conspirator is suspected of having wanted to orchestrate a coup d'etat. The conspirator is suspected of having set up an underground organization from Malaysia to seize the Elysée. Already prosecuted for the kidnapping of little Mia last spring, he was indicted last Friday for criminal conspiracy and remanded in custody. Remy Daillet's lawyer stated that his client disputes any terrorist project.

Seven police officers will face a disciplinary council. They were summoned by the general of the National Police after the murder of Chahinez Boutaa, killed by her husband in Mérignac. A report from various inspections pointed out several failures last June, after this murder. A complaint from the victim was badly dealt with by the police, who will have the opportunity to explain this matter.

Also in the news, "serious deficiencies" in a new slaughterhouse. An investigator from the L214 association infiltrated the veterinary services of a slaughterhouse in Saône et Loire. During inspections, he noted "numerous breaches of the regulations". The images show in particular slaughtered pregnant cows in full gestation.

Several railway unions are calling for demonstrations today and tomorrow against the privatization of the TER Marseille-Toulon-Nice line. They are particularly worried about the consequences this will have for employment. The project was validated this morning by the regional council of Provence-Alpes-Côte-d'Azur, and it is a first in France. The operation of the line, so far managed by the SNCF, will be entrusted from 2025 to Transdev.

And finally, Etienne Daho is to be rewarded by the French academy. On December 3rd, the singer will receive a medal for his vast career: his 40 years of success will be crowned by this prestigious award, given previously to Barbara, Charles Aznavour, Alain Souchon, and Françoise Hardy.
