The wearing of a mask becomes compulsory again in primary schools in 39 departments, just a few weeks after the withdrawal of the measure. This is a consequence of the rebound of the coronavirus epidemic in France. Tomorrow Emmanuel Macron will also take stock of the health situation. He will speak at 8 pm.

After more than a year and a half of closure, the United States reopens its borders today, to vaccinated travelers from 33 countries, including France. In addition to proof of vaccination, you will need to bring a negative covid test of less than three days.

Astronaut Thomas Pesquet is expected to return to Earth tomorrow morning, at around 4:30 am. His departure from the International Space Station, initially scheduled for last night, was postponed by a few hours due to bad weather conditions in Florida, where the shuttle must finish its run.

The plenary assembly of the Conference of Bishops of France is coming to an end. Over the course of a week, the Catholic bishops examined the Sauvé report on child crime within the Church. They are expected to announce measures to fight against this today. We already know that compensation for victims will be individualized.
