A press conference will start in a few moments. The Laval prosecutor will discuss the investigation into the disappearance of a 17-year-old jogger in Mayenne. There has been no sign of her since last night; 200 gendarmes are looking for her. A man is in custody at this point – he is around 40 years old and is already known for common law offenses. For the moment, nothing links him directly to the disappearance of the young woman.

Twenty-four hours after the knife attack on police officers in Cannes: three relatives of the assailants were arrested and taken into custody today. Among them, the attacker's landlord and one of his roommates. The suspect is a 37-year-old Algerian man, who is still hospitalized after having been shot by the police.

Life imprisonment for one of the two defendants in the trial of the murder of Mireille Knoll. The 85-year-old Jewish woman was killed in her home in Paris in 2018. This has been described as "a particularly savage crime". The other suspect risks 18 years in prison. A verdict is expected tomorrow before the Assize Court of Paris.

Emmanuel Macron will address France this evening at 8 pm in a long-awaited speech. Five months after his last speech, the Head of State will take stock of the coronavirus epidemic, and is expected to speak more about the vaccination campaign. One possibility is that a 3rd dose will become compulsory for the elderly and frail. Economic recovery and the pension reform will also be discussed.

And finally, bad weather in Corsica. The two departments of the island have an orange weather warning for rain and flooding. Showers are expected overnight, with up to 80 mm of rain predicted to fall in some areas.
