More details have been released about the disappearance of the 17-year-old jogger in the Mayenne. The teenage girl was found alive yesterday in Sablé sur Sarthe, about ten kilometers from where she disappeared. She explained to the gendarmes that she had been kidnapped on Monday by several kidnappers but was then able to escape and take refuge in a fast food restaurant. She is suffering from shock. An investigation continues to determine what happened.

François Hollande is appearing today at the Special Assize Court in Paris. The former President of the Republic will speak at the trial about the attacks on November 13th, 2015, where he was cited as a witness by an association of victims. He will be questioned in particular on the information he had on the risks of an attack in France.

Two bikers, members of the Lyon rapper collective "Les Dalton", have been arrested and taken into custody this morning for having participated in an urban rodeo. Other members of the group, have already been sentenced for the same thing.

From December 15, those over the age of 65 will have to receive a third booster dose to be able to keep up their health pass. This update was part of a statement by President Macron last night on television. This third dose will eventually be extended to 50 - 64 year olds. The booster campaign will be launched at the beginning of December.

And just after the Head of State's meeting, the Ministry of Health indicated that wearing a mask will finally be compulsory in all schools from next Monday. The measure is being extended to the whole of the country. Initially, this measure concerned only 61 départements where the incidence rate exceeded the alert threshold.

And finally to an extraordinary challenge by Théo Curin. The French disabled swimmer,

who has had all four limbs amputated, will cross Lake Titicaca – a 122 km crossing between Bolivia and Peru. His journey starts today and should last 10 days.
