The vaccination campaign is accelerating in the United States. The third dose of the vaccine has just been authorized for all adults who have had the first two at least six months ago. In France, Emmanuel Macron does not rule out the generalization of the third dose. On the other hand, it is out of the question to confine the unvaccinated.

The Head of State is currently visiting the Hauts de France where he is expected to stay for four days. He will meet with caregivers and patients. A visit criticized by the opposition who sees it as the beginning of the campaign of a presidential candidate.
