What will be the new measures to fight the fifth wave of the coronavirus? The High Authority of Health has just given the green light for a booster dose for all adults five months after the second dose. Therefore, it is expected that the minister of Health Olivier Veran will announce a generalization of the booster shot to all adults. Another measure that Olivier V eran should announce, is the return of masks indoors, where the sanitary pass is requested, and maybe even in some outdoor locations such as Christmas markets for example.

Meanwhile, in Germany, the epidemic situation is also very concerning. The country has crossed the threshold of 100,000 deaths and contaminations have reached a record level. German authorities fear a saturation of hospitals. It is worth noting that 69% of Germans are fully vaccinated, which is less than in other European countries such as France.

After Guadeloupe and Martinique, it is Polynesia's turn to face a general strike, in particular to demand an increase in the minimum wage and the abolition of sanctions for employees who do not comply with the obligation to get vaccinated. Gas stations have been stormed by worried residents. In addition, several flights are canceled from Tahiti.

5 alleged smugglers were arrested after a tragedy that occurred yesterday in the Channel. 27 migrants died off the coast of Calais while trying to reach the United Kingdom. Jean Castex organized this morning an interministerial meeting on this migration issue. The British government announces that it has offered France joint police patrols on the French coast along the English Channel.

And a new episode in the Omar Raddad case is unfolding - The 30-year-old gardener, convicted 30 years ago for the murder of Ghislaine Marchal in the Alpes-Maritimes, before being finally partially pardoned. Today, behind closed doors, a new request for revision is being reviewed at the courthouse of Paris. This first examination is the first step towards a possible revision of the trial.
