One person has died, five were injured and two are missing following the collapse of a building last night, in the Var, in Sanary-sur-Mer. Searches are still in progress.

Faced with the increase in hospitalizations, the emergency response plan is put in place in the PACA region. The measure makes it possible to mobilize medical staff and surgeries can be postponed to optimize hospital resources. In PACA the incidence rate is higher than 420 cases per 100,000 inhabitants. The emergency response plan is in place in Lyon and in the Grand Est.

Emmanuel Macron commits to reopening night clubs "as soon as possible". The Head of State announced this this afternoon as he spoke with the owner of a night club during his trip to Vierzon. And Emmanuel Macron promises exemplary compensation, since starting Friday, nightclubs will be closed for four weeks to curb the fifth wave of the epidemic.

A man was arrested at the Roissy-Charles-de-Gaulle airport. This former member of the Saudi Royal Guard is suspected of being involved in the assassination of journalist Jamal Khashoggi. The journalist was killed three years ago in Istanbul. According to a US intelligence report, the assassination was supposedly validated by Crown Prince Mohammed ben Salman.

And then there is handball tonight with the continuation of the women's world championship. The French team is playing against Montenegro for its third match of the tournament. So far, our Olympic champions have achieved a perfect performance and are already qualified for the next round.
