From today, the health pass will be deactivated for nearly 400,000 French people who have not received their booster dose in time. The 65 and over, who have had no injection for 7 months will therefore be denied access to restaurants, cafes, and theaters. If these people have received a dose of the vaccine after May 15th, they still have a few days to call back and keep their pass

Children aged 5-11 with comorbidities are now eligible for vaccination against the coronavirus. This concerns around 360,000 children. The government then hopes to open up vaccination to all children in this age group by the end of the year. The executive is still awaiting the green light from the Haute Autorité de Santé.

Emmanuel Macron will speak to the French people this evening at 9 pm in an interview that will serve as an update on the five-year term, particular in his management of the health crisis. This interview does not please rivals like Valérie Pécresse. According to her, it is not right to have a candidate president who has television channels opened on demand. Emmanuel Macron has still not officially declared himself a candidate for his succession.

Magistrates, lawyers, and clerks call for a strike to denounce the lack of pay and working conditions. Gatherings are planned in front of the courts, all over France. In Paris, a demonstration is scheduled for noon in front of the Ministry of the Economy and Finance.

A bonus that will help many households: the Christmas bonus is paid today to more than 2 million French people, to the most modest households. A bonus of 152 euros for a single person, and up to 274 euros for a single parent with 2 children. It will be paid automatically by bank transfer.
