An adjustment of measures will be discussed in the new health defense council today. The government might consider making the self-tests free so that the French spend the holidays more serenely. Last night, Emmanuel Macron announced that vaccinated people would not have to be tested to travel to the countries of the European Union.

Joe Biden has said that unvaccinated people will live a "winter of serious disease and death". The President of the United States has once again spoken to defend vaccination. This highlights in particular the presence of the Omicron variant in the US. The country is the most bereaved in the world with more than 800,000 deaths from the coronavirus.
