The debate is heated in the National Assembly as MPs begin to examine the bill on the vaccination pass. According to the Minister of Health, it is a text of "responsibility and equanimity". Olivier Véran once again strongly criticized the fierce opponents of the vaccine, whom he considers selfish. He also gave his support to the parliamentarians of the majority who have received death threats these past days. He promises that we shall "not remain powerless in the face of violence".

An additional help is set up for companies affected by the sanitary restrictions. Partial activity will be reimbursed at 100% without any remaining charges for companies which have lost 65% of their turnover, against 80% previously. Bars and nightclubs are eligible for this help.

Richard Ferrand tested positive for Covid. The President of the National Assembly felt slight symptoms and is now self-isolating. Elisabeth Moreno is also positive. The Minister announces that she will continue to work, but remotely.

As for Marine Le Pen, she postpones her big meeting in Reims. Originally scheduled for January 15, it will finally take place at the beginning of February. The candidate of the *Rassemblement National* for the presidential election explains that this postponement is due to the wave of contaminations.

Meanwhile, Israel continues to roll out the fourth dose of the vaccine and begins injections today for those who are 60 and over, in the midst of a surge in Omicron-related contaminations. Over the past 24 hours, the country has recorded more than 6,500 cases, which is an increase of more than 50% in one day.

Jean-Marc Morandini will be tried for "sexual harassment" and "undeclared work". The host of CNews is suspected of having pushed young amateur actors to exhibit themselves naked. Five of them have filed a complaint. In addition, Jean-Marc Morandini is also indicted in a case of "corruption of minors".

Sébastien Loeb wins the second stage of the Dakar, in Saudi Arabia. The French driver is only nine minutes behind the leader, the Qatari Nasser Al-Attiyah.
