Macron wants to continue to, I quote, "piss off the unvaccinated". Emmanuel Macron does not mince words in his very first interview of the year, published last night in Le Parisien. The Head of State continues to target non-vaccinated people, who he describes as "irresponsible", and wants to deprive them of certain activities in the long-term.

These comments on non-vaccinated people have been deemed reprehensible by the deputies, who decided last night to suspend the debates concerning the bill around the Vaccine Pass. These debates will resume this afternoon at the Assemblée Nationale from 3 pm.

In the meantime, a new Health Defense Council is currently being held at the Elysée. However, no new measures are expected at the end of the council, despite record numbers of contaminations and hospitalizations. The executive takes stock on the measures already in place and the state of the hospital system.

In Guadeloupe, the director of the Pointe à Pitre University Hospital was attacked last night in his office. About fifty activists against the obligatory vaccination of caregivers violently kicked him in the ribs and head. The demonstrators were then exfiltrated by the police.

Sanofi has been found culpable in the Dékapine affair. This drug caused serious and sometimes fatal malformations in thousands of children. The Paris judicial court indicates a lack of vigilance on the part of the laboratory, and of information on the risks of this treatment for epilepsy taken by pregnant women.

And finally, more progress from James Webb. The telescope yesterday deployed its entire heat shield, an essential element for conducting future observations of the cosmos. This space telescope, the most powerful ever designed, should make it possible to better understand the origin of the Universe.
