A new twist in the Novak Djokovic soap opera: The visa of the Serbian tennis player has been canceled by the Australian Minister of Immigration in the name of public interest and health. It will therefore be difficult for the athlete to participate in the Australian Open which starts on Monday. But the story may not yet be over.

However, if the cancellation of his visa is confirmed, Novak Djokovic could be banned from entering Australia for three years.

At least 8,000 additional people will be recruited in National Education. The government made this announcement after the massive mobilization of teachers yesterday. Nearly 80,000 people demonstrated throughout France to denounce the management of the sanitary crisis by the executive.
