Emmanuel Macron is at this moment in the process of detailing the major projects of the French presidency of the European Union to MEPs in Strasbourg. Several subjects will be discussed, including a European minimum salary, climate, and the reform of the Schengen area to better fight against migration.

After a few days of hopeful figures and a drop in the number of cases, a little more than 464,000 cases have been recorded in the past 24 hours. This is a new record in France since the start of the pandemic.

Despite the health crisis, the Salon de l'Agriculture is making a comeback this year. After being canceled last year, the event will take place from February 26th to March 6th, at Porte de Versailles in Paris. This 58th edition will be held with the wearing of a mandatory mask and vaccination pass, if the measure comes into force. Ventilation will also be optimized.

Gaspard Ulliel, known for his role in Hannibal Rising, has been in a ski accident, which happened yesterday in the Rosière area of Savoie. According to BFM TV, the actor was unconscious when help arrived. His agent has not shared details of the state of his health. He has been transported to a hospital in Grenoble.

Will Claude Guéant be released from prison? The request for the release of the former Minister of the Interior under Nicolas Sarkozy will be examined today. Guéant has been imprisoned since December for embezzlement of public funds. The request was made by Claude Guéant after having settled his debt of just over 133,000 euros to the Public Treasury, three days after his conviction.
