From today, job seekers will be credited with the inflation allowance, worth 100 euros. This bonus was already paid to scholarship students, self-employed workers, and public and private employees. The only criterion is an income less than 2,000 euros net per month.

To help the French face the increase in the price of fuel, the government may decide to deduct the mileage allowance from taxes. Prices increased again last week. The price of diesel, for example, has increased by 3.26 cents per liter. A meeting is scheduled today between the Minister of the Economy Bruno Le Maire and Prime Minister Jean Castex to discuss the subject.

In the rest of the news, Emmanuel Macron says he is concerned about the Ukrainian crisis. During a videoconference meeting last night with the American president and European leaders, the head of state pleaded for a de-escalation. The United States have placed 8,500 soldiers on alert, and they are ready to intervene in the event of a Russian invasion of Ukraine.

A first victory for all CBD stores. The Conseil d'Etat has temporarily suspended the government decree that prohibits the marketing of hemp leaves. Professionals in the sector could no longer sell flowers and raw leaves to smoke or consume as a herbal tea. The highest administrative court considered the measure to be disproportionate, but still has to examine the case.

In Cameroon, at least 8 people have been killed and 40 people injured during a party celebrating the victory of the national football team in qualifying for the quarter-finals of the African Cup of Nations. A major crowd movement broke out around the Yaoundé stadium before the match.

And finally, the James Webb Space Telescope reached its final orbit yesterday, 1.5 million km from Earth. This is an ideal distance to observe the universe and better understand it, NASA said.
