Emmanuel Macron will speak with Vladimir Putin on the phone today. The head of state is on a diplomatic mission to ease tensions between Russia and Ukraine. The situation became tense when Russia deployed nearly 100,000 soldiers near the border and the United States threatened Russia with reprisals in the event of an invasion of Ukraine.

A political betrayal, even a stab in the back. Marine Le Pen was abandoned by her own niece. Marion Maréchal has announced that she will not support the candidate of the *Rassemblement National*. She may join the support of Eric Zemmour and will give a definitive answer within a month.

Another consequence of Covid 19 is the surge in hospitalizations in psychiatric hospitals, especially among teenagers. There has been a 40% increase in requests for admission to children's psychiatric units. A flow that the services cannot necessarily absorb and waiting lists are getting longer.
