The red weather alert is maintained in the Reunion Island. The cyclone is still present. "The worst is still to come" announced the prefect of the region. Gusts reach up to 150 kilometers per hour the rain is expected to intensify in the next few hours. No deaths have been reported so far but at least a dozen people have been injured.

France and the United States agree, so far, regarding the situation in Ukraine. Emmanuel Macron and Joe Biden met last night to agree on the response to be provided in the event of an invasion of the country by Russia. On this subject, the French Head of State must talk today at the end of the afternoon with Vladimir Putin.

And then we now know that the honorary president of the Victoires de la Musique ceremony will be Stromae. The Belgian artist will therefore succeed Jean-Louis Aubert. The ceremony will take place on February 11.
