The red cyclone alert will remain in effect in the Reunion Island until at least tomorrow. This was decided by the prefect of the island Jacques Billant. The Reunionese are told to stay at home at least until tomorrow morning as the cyclone continues its trajectory. Nearly 45,000 homes are still without electricity.

Patrick Balkany says that today's decision of Court of Appeal of Rouen "Is absolutely unfair". The couple's electronic bracelets are being revoked after multiple violations. As a reminder, they had been sentenced to several years in prison for tax evasion in 2020. After the hospitalization of Isabelle Balkany this afternoon following this decision, the former mayor de Levallois plans to file a complaint.

A matter has been referred to the public prosecutor of Grenoble during the trial of Nordahl Lelandais. A video was recorded at the end of the hearing, which is considered a criminal offence. The recording was then shared on social media. The former dog handler has been on trial since Monday for the murder of Maelys in August 2017.

The digitized medical file "Mon Espace Santé" is being launched today. It will be set up for everyone within the next few months and will consolidate prescriptions, appointments and test results all in one place - A revolution in the same way as was the Carte Vitale according to the Ministry of Health.
