Paris is barricading itself. Armored vehicles have been dispatched to the capital by the gendarmerie to prevent blockades of participants of the “convoi de la liberté”. Nearly 2000 vehicles are on their way to Paris for a large mobilization planned for this weekend to denounce health restrictions. As a reminder, the gathering has been prohibited by the police headquarters.

Regarding the health crisis, the government announced today that several measures will be lifted or lightened. First, concerning masks: they will no longer be mandatory from February 28 in closed places subjected to the vaccination pass. For example, bars, restaurants sports halls or cinemas. The only exception is in public transportation, including trains and planes. And then in schools, the health protocol has been lightened: on February 21, students and staff will no longer be required to wear masks outdoors. And from February 28, only one self-test will be requested for contact cases against 3 previously.

In the rest of the news, he will tell his truth. He was heard again by the judges in the case of the disappearance of his wife Delphine in December 2020 in Cagnac les Mines in the Tarn. Her body was never found. At the end of his hearing, his lawyers announced their intention to formulate a new request for release.
