Today, the vaccination pass will be deactivated for more than 4 million French people. Now, you must have taken your booster dose within 4 months rather than within 7 months. If you received your booster dose on October 15th, your QR code will no longer be valid, except if you have had Covid in the meantime. In addition, the recovery certificate is now valid for 4 months and no longer 6.

In Canada, in the face of blockages by anti-sanitary measures demonstrators for 2 weeks, Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced the use of the Emergency Measures Act. The law allows him to have recourse to "extraordinary measures" to deal with a national crisis.

War threats escalate in Ukraine. After visiting Kyiv yesterday, German Chancellor Olaf Sholz will be in Moscow today to try to ease tensions with Russia. Westerners fear an invasion of Ukraine by the Russians. The Ukrainian president has said that he expects an attack from Moscow tomorrow. A "day of unity" has been decreed in order to mobilize the population.

Claude Guéant has been hospitalized. The former Minister of the Interior, victim of heart problems, will undergo surgery. Claude Guéant was to be tried in Nanterre today for allegations of fraud for the reimbursement of the expenses of his 2012 legislative campaign. The trial is therefore postponed.

In sport, will France win a 12th medal in the Winter Olympics in Beijing? The men's relay in biathlon is happening right now. Quentin Fillon Maillet, already 4 times medalist in these Olympics, will go last.
