Vladimir Putin has crossed the red line by recognizing the separatist territories in eastern Ukraine. European leaders are now trading diplomacy for sanctions. EU foreign ministers gathered this afternoon to agree on retaliation, which includes targeting Russian banks and access to European markets.

And tonight, Vladimir Putin is asking the Russian Senate to send soldiers to support the separatists in Ukraine. Joe Biden will speak at 8 o'clock.
