A journalist openly denounced the war in Ukraine on a Russian television set. A little earlier, Emmanuel Macron announced that he wanted to welcome the journalist to France. Diplomatic discussions are underway.

The Head of State was in Maine-et-Loire this afternoon and visited a center for refugees. He recalled that France was able to accommodate 100,000 refugees, or even more. He also wants to relieve the neighboring countries of Ukraine which are taking in large numbers of refugees, such as Moldova. According to the latest UN figures, three million people have fled Ukraine.

As a result of the increase in fuel prices in France, the oil depots of Brest and Lorient were blocked this morning by transporters, farmers and even fishermen. These professionals ask the government to freeze taxes.

What if Jean Lassalle withdrew his presidential candidacy? He is "strongly considering" this possibility. Jean Lassalle said so this morning in front of local elected officials, in Montrouge. According to the MP for Pyrénées-Atlantiques, "this election no longer has any meaning, it resembles nothing". He also regrets not being invited to the debates. The candidate recently launched a "tour de France" by bus for his campaign. This is the third time that Jean Lassalle participates in a presidential election.

The decision on Cédric Jubillar's fourth request for release is expected on March 22nd. The request is being examined by the investigating chamber of the Toulouse Court of Appeal. The general prosecutor's office requested he remain in detention. Cédric Jubillar, who has been detained for almost a year, is indicted for the murder of his wife Delphine. The nurse has not given any sign of life since December 2020.

And then the Haute-Garonne and the Tarn are still under orange weather alert for violent wind. Last night winds reached over 110 kilometers per hour in Lauragais.
