A neutral Ukraine, without the possibility of joining NATO or hosting nuclear armies. This was one of Moscow's main demands, and Kyiv says it is ready to study it in depth. Volodymyr Zelensky extends his hand to Vladimir Putin as new negotiations take place tomorrow in Turkey. But if the principle of neutrality is emerging, it remains to be seen in what form. According to Carole Potter, professor of geopolitics of Russia at the University of Montpellier, the two countries are not ready to sign a ceasefire.

The separatist territory of Lugansk could soon hold a referendum to join Russia, a scenario identical to the annexation of Crimea to Russia 8 years ago.

In this context, things are not getting any better in terms of fuel. After a week of calm, fuel prices rose again last week in France, exceeding two euros per liter. Diesel prices have increased the most. The government discount of 18 cents per liter will come into effect this Friday.

Differentiated traffic will end tomorrow in the Paris region, with the end of the fine particle pollution episode. The measure has been in force since Saturday, with aims to reduce the circulation of pollution and fine particles. The speed of vehicles was also reduced.
