A new food scandal, in less than 2 weeks. After Buitoni frozen pizzas and Kinder chocolates, the Graindorger brand must also now recall its products. Six cheeses sold in supermarkets could contain the bacteria responsible for listeriosis, according to the government site Rappel Conso. This is a rare but particularly deadly food infection.

Another scandal, that of the Orpéa group, which is accused of mistreatment of its residents. The government has made public the report on the management of these retirement homes. The document of more than 500 pages points to many dysfunctions of the group. This report confirms that in some nursing homes, priority is given to financial performance, to the detriment of the well-being of residents.

The war in Ukraine continues. EU foreign ministers will meet in Brussels today to impose new sanctions on Moscow. After the massacre of civilians in Bucha, near Kyiv, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky spoke yesterday before the UN Security Council. He has asked for Russia to be excluded from this Council.

A conflict that will inevitably be at the heart of debates in the presidential election. With 4 days to go before the first round, the candidates are increasing their meetings and trips. The ecologist Yannick Jadot will notably be in Bas-Rhin. Phillipe Poutou will hold a meeting at 7 pm in Bordeaux. The candidate Nicolas Dupont-Aignan will be at a meeting in Paris.

The far-right essayist Alain Soral has been sentenced to 3 months in prison by a Swiss public prosecutor for homophobia. In question were remarks made against a 24-hour journalist in a video published on his site.
