Ukraine fears an imminent Russian offensive in the east of the country. The inhabitants of the region have been called by local authorities to evacuate as quickly as possible, in particular in Dombass - A strategic area that has become the priority target of the Kremlin, which has been repositioning its troops for several weeks.

In this conflict Victor Orbane will try to be a mediator. The Hungarian nationalist Prime Minister, known to be close to Vladimir Putin spoke today with the Russian President to propose a meeting with the Ukrainian, French and German leaders. The objective is an immediate ceasefire.

The family of Yvan Colonna is filing a complaint against the French State. Legal action has been taken before the Marseille administrative court. As a reminder, the Corsican independence activist died on March 21 after being violently attacked by a fellow prisoner in the prison of Arles. His relatives believe that the prison administration is legally responsible for this death according to one of their lawyers.

The production of Buitoni pizzas is now prohibited in the factory of Caudry in the North. This was decided by the prefecture after several serious cases of contamination with E.coli - cases which particularly affected the youngest. Two children have died. An investigation for manslaughter has been opened by the Paris prosecutor's office to shed light on this case.

There is another case of contamination which concerns 6 cheeses from the brand Graindorge. A Brie, two Coulommiers and two Normanvilles sold in supermarkets were recalled because possibly contaminated by the bacterium responsible for listeriosis. Listeriosis is a rare food infection but particularly dangerous, even deadly.
