Météo France places 3 departments under orange weather alert for strong winds as the storm Diego approaches. The episode will start tomorrow at the beginning of the afternoon with gusts reaching 80 to 110 kilometers per hour.

Also in the news: The investigation continues with regard to the recall of Kinder products. The Ferrero company indicates that salmonella had already been detected on December 15 at the Arlon production site in Belgium. A date well before the recall of the products. In France, 21 cases of salmonellosis linked to the consumption of these chocolates have been discovered. This happens just after the recall of pizzas from the Buitoni brand contaminated with E Coli.

A 12-year-old girl was stabbed to death yesterday in Villeurbanne. The main suspect wanted by the police was finally found dead this morning. It was the neighbor of the victim. The investigation continues to determine the motive and the circumstances of the murder of the teenager.

The tweet was not well received. France summoned the Russian Ambassador this afternoon after his comment on the abuses in Boutcha. The tweet was since deleted. Moscow categorically denies being behind the crimes in the Ukrainian city and speaks of falsification of images.

And in the meantime, on the front the Russian offensive is not weakening, in particular in the East. Authorities consider that this is the last chance for civilians to evacuate the zone which is surrounded by the Russian army. Dombass is from now on the priority target of the Kremlin. Evacuations are taking place in the absence of any ceasefire and in very difficult conditions.
