A shooting took place in a New York subway station this afternoon. At least 13 people were injured by gunfire in Brooklyn. A manhunt is underway in the city for a man wearing a gas mask. Police are asking residents to avoid the area.

Vladimir Poutine sticks to his guns. The Russian president says that the massacre of Boutcha is "Fake" and compares these accusations to those concerning the use of chemical weapons by the regime of Bashar al-Assad in Syria. According to Ukrainian authorities, several hundreds of bodies of civilians were found in these past days in cities neighboring Kiev after the withdrawal of Russian troops from this region at the end of March.

In France, Marine Le Pen presents her vision of democracy: She spoke to the press this afternoon and talked about setting up a citizens' initiative referendum and discussed her program. This was also the opportunity to attack her opponent in the second round of this election. According to her, Emmanuel Macron did nothing for democracy during his mandate which led to a break with the voters.

As for Emmanuel Macron, he is currently in Mulhouse discussing health issues. He expresses his gratitude to those who fought Covid. He also criticized the attitude of Marine Le Pen during the health crisis, as "She wanted to vaccinate with chloroquine and an ineffective Russian vaccine"...

Two people have died following a ULM crash in Ariège. This happened this morning in the town of Prate Bonrepaux. The victims are the pilot and his passenger. The aircraft crashed in a field for an unknown reason. An investigation has been opened.

And then the wind is calming down in the southwest of France. The orange weather has been lifted in Haute Garonne and Tarn.
