The presidential campaign is in full swing with candidates present on all fronts. Marine Le Pen has arrived in Avignon to hold her first meeting in-between rounds. Her objective is to win a maximum of votes in this city which placed Jean luc Mélenchon in the lead in the first round. As for Emmanuel Macron, he arrived in Le Havre in the stronghold of his former Prime Minister Edouard Philippe. His speech will focus on ecology.

Two months after the fatal fire in Saint Laurent de la Salanque in Pyrénées Orientales, the investigation continues. The tragedy cost the lives of 8 people on February 14. The public prosecutor issued a press release today to communicate about the progress of the investigation. The analyzes make it possible to exclude the use of explosives and the existence of a gas leak in the city, a criminal fire is therefore being considered. As a reminder, three men have been indicted and imprisoned in this case

There are suspicions of insulin poisoning in an EHPAD in Loire Atlantique. This was revealed by Ouest France. An investigation has just been opened by the Nantes prosecutor's office. A patient was injected with insulin without her knowledge - a hormone used in the treatment of diabetes. The elderly and dependent person survived but the gendarmes are interested in two other suspicious deaths.
