The presidential campaign officially ends tomorrow at midnight. After midnight tomorrow, no more public speaking and no more campaigning. Marine Le Pen and Emmanuel Macron have, therefore, just over 24 hours to convince. The latest polls give a clear advantage to the LREM candidate.

Regarding the abstention rate, it could be more important than in the first round.

While waiting - and after the big debate - both presidential candidates are back on the ground. Emmanuel Macron is in Seine Saint Denis today for trip dedicated to the problem of "unsanitary housing and urban renewal". Marine Le Pen is in her stronghold in the Hauts de France. The candidate of the *Rassemblement National* was in the Somme and is now expected in the Pas de Calais for a meeting in Arras.

6 months after the fatal TER accident in Ciboure, the investigation for manslaughter was closed without further action. This was announced by the public prosecutor of Bayonne. On October 12, three Algerian migrants lost their lives, crushed by a TER as they were sleeping on the tracks shortly after illegally crossing the Spanish border.

Vladimir Putin has said that "The liberation of Mariupol is a success". After 57 days of war, the Kremlin ensures that the entire city and its strategic Ukrainian port are now Russian -With the exception of the factory of Azovstal where a few resistance fighters remain.
