The campaign for the second round of the presidential election ends tonight at midnight. Then it's time for the reserve period until Sunday 8 p.m.

In the meantime, Marine Le Pen was in Arras yesterday. The candidate for the *Rassemblement National* had her last meeting and once again called to block Macron. She said he was "A condescending and arrogant President who does not like the French". Marine Le Pen will stay in the department today, before ending her campaign in Abbeville this evening.

As for, Emmanuel Macron, he was in Seine Saint Denis yesterday. He put on boxing gloves and exchanged a few blows with a young man in the Auguste Delaune stadium in Saint Denis. He is expected today in Figeac in the Lot.
