Emmanuel Macron's stated objective is to bring the country together. He repeated this last night, shortly after his election: "I am no longer the president of a party, but that of all the French people." Now, it remains to be seen how he can get there. For the political scientist Thomas Guénolé, this union will be made during the formation of the next government.

Jean Castex will resign from his government at the end of the week as tradition dictates. Several names are circulating to replace him, but Emmanuel Macron has already mentioned the possibility of appointing a woman at Matignon.

And the *Rassemblement National* is already preparing for the legislative elections of June. The party of Marine Le Pen wants to constitute a real opposition and form a parliamentary group in the National Assembly. This requires obtaining at least 15 MPs - all without an alliance with the party *Reconquête* despite the offer of Eric Zemmour.

The trial of the disaster of Brétigny-sur-Orge begins. The SNCF and a railway worker are on trial before the Evry criminal court for manslaughter after the derailment of the Paris-Limoges train in 2013. The tragedy had resulted in 7 deaths and more than 400 people injured.

In Ukraine, a ceasefire is decreed in Mariupol. It entered into force this afternoon following a decision made by Russia. The objective is to allow the evacuation of civilians. However, according to kiev, no agreement has been reached to set up a humanitarian corridor.
