Olivier Faure arrived at the headquarters of *La France Insoumise*... The 1st Secretary of the PS comes to recall the demands of his party to find an agreement with the movement of Jean-Luc Mélenchon for the legislative elections - An agreement which could be finalized this evening. Discussions have been going on since this morning. Among the main problems are Europe and the distribution of constituencies. As a reminder, last night it was the Greens who sealed their alliance with the *Insoumis* around a common program.

On the right, it's time for a settling of scores. The *Republicai*n MP François-Xavier Bellamy calls on Nicolas Sarkozy for clarity. According to him, the former President must now indicate whether he wants be part of the majority or if he believes in the need for a right-wing opposition. We recall that Nicolas Sarkozy had never supported the LR candidate Valérie Pécresse during the presidential election, before calling to rally behind Emmanuel Macron for the second round.

Also in the news, about 50 people remain in police custody after the violent acts committed yesterday during the demonstrations of May 1 in Paris. A firefighter was also attacked while trying to put out a fire. Bank and insurance storefronts and street furniture were also degraded.

2 Parisian leaders of the communication agency Havas have stepped down after accusations of harassment and sexual assault. They are suspected of having tried to kiss or indecently touch several times several of their collaborators. Twenty anonymous testimonies had been published on social networks these past weeks, evoking a sexist atmosphere within the company. Havas is a subsidiary of Vivendi, which has also launched an internal audit.

After 2 years of health crisis, what is the state of the physical and mental health of our children? This is the challenge of this study launched today by *Santé Public France*. 30,000 schoolchildren aged 3 to 11 will be assessed. The first results are expected at the end of the year.
