Still no agreement reached between France Insoumise and the Socialists. The discussions around an alliance for the legislative elections have still not succeeded, but they will continue today. Among the sticking points are retirement age and the number of constituencies, among others. In any case, the alliance between France Insoumise and the Communists was sealed yesterday afternoon.

The woman accused of having assaulted a firefighter in Paris during the demonstrations of May 1st will be judged today in immediate appearance. In a video, we see her kicking the helmet of the firefighter, while he was trying to put out a fire.

In the United States, the Republican Governor of Oklahoma has announced that he has signed a law, one of the most restrictive in the country, prohibiting abortion after 6 weeks of pregnancy, even in the event of rape or incest. The text was signed yesterday, as the American Supreme Court is preparing to reconsider the right to abortion at the federal level.

A 5th investigation opened in France by the national anti-terrorist prosecutor's office for "war crimes" in Ukraine. The events occurred between March 26th and April 7th. A French man was injured after bombings in Borodyanka near Kyiv. This is where hundreds of civilians were killed during the passage of Russian troops.

The World Health Organization is sounding the alarm. It is worried about the resurgence of obesity in Europe, where 1 in 4 adults are concerned. This is more than in other countries, apart from the United States. According to the World Health Organization, obesity is responsible for more than 1.2 million deaths per year in Europe.
