Education was at the heart of the visit of Emmanuel Macron to Marseille. Nine months after the launch of the "*Marseille en grand*" plan, the president came to take stock of the situation in schools of the city of Marseille. He said that he wanted to generalize the school of the future, a measure which gives more freedom to the teaching teams. Emmanuel Macron also announced two concrete measures for the beginning of the school year: the return of mathematics as an option in 11th grade and the introduction of 30 minutes of sports every day in elementary schools.

Meanwhile, future higher education students will get the first responses from Parcoursup this evening at 7 o'clock. They will then know if the higher education establishments accepted their candidacies.

After the fiasco of the Champions League final on Saturday, nothing has changed with regard to the France-Denmark game scheduled for tomorrow evening. Nearly 1,300 security officers will be deployed at the Stade de France – A classic security measure according to the French Football Federation. This evening the Minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin, brings together the prefect of police of Paris, Didier Lallement, and his services.
