Health Minister Brigitte Bourguignon announces a first series of measures for emergencies services in hospitals in response to the concerns of caregivers. Overtime for non-medical staff will be paid double, student nurses will be immediately employable, and retired caregivers will be able to resume their activity this summer while receiving their pension. However, for Christophe Pruhdomme, spokesperson for the CGT Santé, these emergency measures will further accentuate the crisis.

These first measures will be supplemented by the proposals of the flash mission commissioned from the emergency physician François Braun.

Twenty searches were carried out at Orpéa today. The retirement home group is targeted for the management of its establishments, after the revelations of the book "Les Fossoyeurs". The group is suspected of institutional mistreatment and embezzlement of public funds.

The requisitions began at the trial of the attacks of November 13. The indictment, spread over three days before the special circuit court, will end on Friday with the sentences for Salah Abdeslam and his 19 co-accused. Twelve of them face life in prison.

And then will the Tour de France 2024 take on an Italian accent? According to the *Gazzetta dello Sport*, the start of this 2024 edition will be in Florence. Italian journalists also announce that because of the Olympics, for the first time in history, the big loop will not arrive in Paris but in Nice.
