France will supply new weapons to Ukraine. 6 Caesar cannons will soon be delivered; this was confirmed by Emmanuel Macron earlier today from Kiev. The president's historic visit is his 1st trip to the country since beginning of the war 4 months ago. Emmanuel Macron spoke earlier with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky to recall the full support of France and Europe for his country. Moreover, France, Germany, Italy and Romania are in favor of an immediate candidate status for Ukraine's accession to the European Union.

Also in the news: The heat wave, which is in full force: 12 departments are under red weather alert. The alert concerns a large part of the south-west quarter of the country, from Vendée to Tarn via Haute Garonne and Gironde. 25 departments are also under orange alert for high temperatures, which come very early for the season. The temperatures will continue to climb until this evening. 40 degrees have already been reached this afternoon in the town of Argeliers in Aude, and it's not over, warns Météo France. The heat wave could last until the middle of next week.
