Elisabeth Borne faces a motion of no confidence from *La France Insoumise*. The leader of the party, Mathilde Panot, spoke earlier in the National Assembly and once again criticized the refusal of the head of government to submit to a vote of confidence.

And following Mathilde Panot's speech, Elisabeth Borne then answered, stating that despite the invectives and despite the situation, she remains convinced that the compromise will allow action. As for the vote of the motion of confidence, it is planned for early this evening but has no chance of succeeding.

Meanwhile, the oppositions are demanding clarity from Emmanuel Macron, after the publication of an investigation into the links between the Head of State and Uber. When he was still Minister of the Economy, he is said to have greatly facilitated the installation in France of the VTC platform. The MP of the *Rasemblement National*, Sébastien Chenu, speaks of the "first scandal of the President's term" and the MP of a La France Insoumise, Alexis Corbière, is considering the creation of a parliamentary commission of inquiry.

Beauvais will finally have a new mayor. Caroline Cayeux, appointed Minister Delegate for Local Authorities, will leave her position. However, she had initially assured that she wanted to keep her mandate as mayor, which she has held for more than 20 years. Her resignation will not take place immediately, the time to prepare her succession.

And then in soccer, Paul Pogba is officially back at Juventus Turin. The Frenchman, at the end of his contract at Manchester United, has signed up until 2026 with the Turin club. A club he knows well since he had already played there between 2012 and 2016.
