Emmanuel Macron wants the Olympic Games to be unforgettable, surprising, and unique. This is what the Head of State said this morning to the participants in the first Olympic and Paralympic Council. A dozen ministers and secretaries of state were present to discuss the security and budget of the games of 2024.

The health bill is back at the National Assembly. Two weeks after its vote at first reading, and after the adoption of a modified version of the text by the Senate, this afternoon gives way to new debates. They will focus only on government amendments, or those that are accepted.

A double homicide took place in Essonne, where a woman in her fifties and her 14-year-old daughter were stabbed to death this morning in Vigneux-sur-Seine. The suspect, in his 40s, was taken into custody, where he will undergo a psychiatric evaluation. The double homicide was committed in the apartment of the suspect and the woman was his ex-partner.

in Gironde, the situation is improving day by day. All the evacuees are now able to return to their homes. As a reminder, more than 21,000 hectares have burned down in almost 2 weeks.

In Tunisia, more than 9 million people are called to vote today. They must decide on a referendum imposed by the Head of State, Kais Saïed. The current president wants to have a new Constitution, which establishes an ultra-presidential regime. The text raises concern if it is approved, as it would mean a return to a dictatorial regime similar to that before the Revolution of 2011.

And then cycling: After the end of the Tour, it's time for the women's Tour de France. The 2nd stage was between Meaux and Provins and was won by the veteran Marianne Voss. Tomorrow, the 3rd stage will go from Reims to Epernay.
