6000 hectares have been ravaged by a fire in Gironde. The flames also reached the Landes. Civil security speaks of an extraordinary firepower and a situation considered very unfavorable. Nearly twenty homes were destroyed and 3,500 people evacuated.

Gérald Darmanin is expected this morning in Mostuéjols in Aveyron. The Minister of the Interior will assess the situation which affects the department and the neighbor region of Lozère.

Fires are favored by the weather. The heat wave is still present in France and affects 16 departments in the West and Southwest of the country, from Tarn to Loire Atlantique via Gironde.

Also in the news this morning: This information from our colleagues at BFM. Border Patrol opened fire on a man this morning at the Roissy airport. According to their sources, the assailant was a homeless man armed with a knife. The individual was shot in the abdomen.

The Beluga has left for Ouistreham. As a reminder, the animal had been in the Seine for a week and was pulled out of the water last night. His state of health is considered alarming. A return to the sea is currently being considered.

In Ukraine, 13 civilians were killed last night in Dnipro Petrovsk. They were supposedly victims of Russian bombings according to the Ukrainian governor of the region.

It is a trial that is expected to last fifteen weeks - That of Benjamin Mendy. The trial begins today in Chester. The French footballer is accused of several rapes, attempted rape, and sexual assault. The events supposedly took place in his home in the north of England. He has been under judicial supervision since last January. The verdict is expected next November.
