The video of inmates go-karting in Fresnes prison that would have gone on to become a program called "Kohlantess" is no longer online. It has been removed by the production. It has emerged that one of the participants may have been an inmate sentenced to ten years for rape. The games organisers say they were not aware of this. In a press release, the producers state that the inclusion of this inmate in the games breaks the trust established between them and the prison authorities and the ministry of justice which gave the games the green light.

Two children were killed last night in Lyon in a road accident. The two of them were travelling on scooters down a bus lane when they were hit by an ambulance. The ambulance was on its way to handle an emergency situation. The driver and colleague were taken to hospital in a state of shock.

Jonathan Destin, the young man who became the face of anti-school bullying campaigns after an attempt on his life in 2011, has died by suicide. Destin told the story of being subjected to years of harassment in a book that was adapted into a TV movie. He has died at 27 years old. An investigation has been opened to confirm the circumstances of his death.

In the United States, Donald Trump has requested the appointment of an independent expert after the search carried out on his Florida residence. Investigators suspect the former president of having violated the law on the strict regulation of the possession of confidential documents. Donald Trump claims the search was "illegal and unconstitutional".

The drug test taken by the Prime Minister of Finland has come back as negative. Sanna Marin came under fire from critics after a video emerged in which she was seen partying with her friends. Some accused her of being under the influence of drugs. Marin denied the accusations and now the results of the test prove her right.

And finally, to football over in England. Manchester United is breathing new life after bagging a win against Liverpool last night. The start of the season had proved tricky for the Red Devils but last night saw them win at home against Liverpool, with a final score of 2-1.
