A special commission dedicated to colonisation and the war in Algeria is going to be set up. Emmanuel Macron made the announcement yesterday from Algeria. The President said that the commission will be made up of French and Algerian historians in order to look into the entire period of history, with no taboos. Emmanuel Macron continues on his visit to Algeria today.

In Ukraine, the Zaporizhia nuclear power plant has been reconnected to the electricity grid. The news came from Kyiv last night. Yesterday the plant was disconnected for the first time in its history. Russian bombings damaged lines of communication to the plant.

In France, the Minister of Education has expressed that France's education system is facing a complex situation. With less than a week before the start of the school year, Pap Ndiaye has confirmed the hiring of 3,000 contractual teachers. He also reiterated a 10% rise in teacher salaries.

There is good news on wildfires in the Gironde. The Teste de buche fire has now been extinguished. Last night, the prefecture which also specifies that "the situation is improving" in the Landiras area, thanked the firefighters and everyone involved in tackling the fires and the surveillance of the disaster areas

And finally to football, the suspense is over for Paris Saint Germain and Olympique Marseille. The draw for the Champions League took place last night in Istanbul. PSG will have to play Juventus Turin, Benfica Lisbon and Maccabi Haifa while Olympique Marseille face Frankfurt, Tottenham and Sporting Portugal.
